Job Summary:

A Journeyman Carpenter must have the skills and experience to perform all construction tasks for home building, from breaking ground to completion. A Journeyman Carpenter must be capable of running small jobs and crews unassisted. Must be tooled to the extent necessary to perform all phases of home construction.

Essential Job Requirements:

- Education: Minimum of high school diploma or GED
- Experience: Minimum of 5 years construction experience
- A similar combination of both education and experience will be considered

Preferred Skills and Abilities:

- Able to read blueprints
- Perform all facets of construction from frame to finish carpentry
- Wear personal protective gear such as safety glasses and gloves at all times on the job.

- Provide guidance and supervision for apprentice carpenters and laborers
- Be responsible for tool care and maintenance
- Set an example for all employees on the crew
- Stay busy at all times.
- Be on time every day
