

LABORER

Job Summary:

A Laborer is any person hired, to work on a construction site, who may have little or no experience in the construction field. Laborers are required to perform any and all tasks from cleanliness of the job site to operation of hand power tools and light equipment. In addition, laborers will be required to assist in general building.

Essential Job Requirements:

Job Qualifications:

- Education: Minimum of high school diploma or GED
- Experience: No experience necessary, just willingness to learn
- A similar combination of both education and experience will be considered

Preferred Skills and Abilities:

- Assist Foreman and Carpenters in construction as necessary.
- Use proper lifting techniques when moving lumber and other materials. Always ask for assistance when moving heavy items.
- Wear personal protective gear such as safety glasses and gloves at all times on the job.

Role & Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the Laborer to:

- Keep the job site clean, floors swept, and debris consolidated, extension cords organized.
- Keep materials stacked, covered, and in an accessible location.
- Keep company tools cleaned, oiled, and in a good state of repair.
- Stay busy at all times.
- Be on time every day.
